







Acacia Honey

SWEET FLORAL DELICATE

Acacia honey has a mild, sweet, floral flavour and is, therefore, one of the most popular honey varieties.

It is a good choice for mixing with beverages because it sweetens without changing the taste of the drink.

Acacia Honey is also an excellent choice for cooking because of its mild flavour.

It has hints of vanilla flavour and no aftertaste.



Buckwheat Honey



DARK MALTY STRONG

Honey bees that collect and process the nectar of buckwheat flowers create a dark honey with full, robust flavour. Buckwheat Honey can range in colour from coppery yellow to purple or nearly black. The average jar is dark amber with a reddish tint when held to the light. Compared with lighter-coloured varieties, buckwheat honey has a similar taste to molasses.



Blossom Honey

COMPLEX FLORAL SEASONAL

Our Scottish Blossom Honey comes from our own apiary at the Falkland estate in Fife which is located in the heart of the estate near apple orchard and surrounded by wildflowers and woodland. Our bees get to enjoy apple blossom nectar as well as clover, Himalayan balsam, oak, lime and other wildflowers. It is organic land so our bees are thriving there and the honey produced is very tasty.



Coriander Honey

FLORAL FRESH SURPRISING

Coriander blossom raw honey is golden amber in colour and has a specific taste and mild aroma, which is levied two weeks after extraction. It's a very rare type of honey. The nectar of coriander is highly dependent on weather conditions and usually the plant produces it every five to six years. And even then, the production is low. As a rule, a hive can give about 20 to 25 kilos of multi-floral honey, and only 2 kilos of coriander honey. As a result, this type of honey is rare and expensive.



Forest Honey

FRUITY COMPLEX MEDIUM SWEET

Forest Honey flow is often strong in late wet summers. It may be known generically as “Tree Honey” but also by the name of the particular source plant, “Fir Honey”, “Pine Honey”, “Lime Tree Honey”, “Oak Honey” etc. Even today many people believe this honey is created from sap secreted directly from the tree itself. This is not the case. Only about 1% of the time do plants exude a honeydew-like substance directly that bees will use, and this is usually as the result of an injury or shock to the plant.



Heather Honey

STRONG FLORAL PUNGENT

Our Scottish Heather Honey comes from our own apiary at the Glen Eagles Hotel, Falkland Estate and in the Scottish Borders. It is rich in taste and very aromatic. Not to mention it's full of pollen for those who have allergies and need a helping hand in springtime!



Honeydew Honey

DARK MALTY BITTERISH

Honeydew honey is a type of honey produced by bees using honeydew, which, like nectar, is a sugary liquid that derives from sap. To better understand what honeydew honey is, we need to know that bees can produce honey by collecting and transforming two different nutrients: nectar and, indeed, honeydew.

The honeydew, however, unlike nectar, is not produced directly from plants, but from insects that absorb sap from plants to live and multiply, and secrete a product still rich in nutrients, especially sugars: honeydew. Honeydew droplets stick to leaves, branches, barks and so on; the bees find it, collect it and, through their work, produce honey.





Linden Honey

MINTY FLORAL AROMATIC

The intensity of the aroma and the taste is stronger than the colour would indicate. The usual rule of darker is stronger is broken with Linden honey. When very fresh it has a greenish colour, but after time it becomes clear to amber with a yellow tone. The aroma is described as woody, pharmacy fresh and also described as minty, balsamic, menthol and camphor. It has low acidity, medium sweetness and sometimes a light bitterness. It has a persistent aftertaste and is slightly astringent. The crystallisation rate is medium to fast with fine to medium sized crystals.

Rapeseed Honey

VERY SWEET CREAMY FLORAL

Rapeseed honey is considered to be the ugly duckling of the honey world. It is one of the first major food sources for bees and a very important aspect to a good start of the beekeeping season. The girls tend to multiply very quickly due to high pollen content on the OSR flowers.

This honey is known to help with hay fever in the spring as it is rich in pollen. Best is to start your hay fever curative a few months in advance to allow your immune system to get used to pollens.





Sunflower Honey

VERY SWEET SEASONAL MILD

This strong flavoured honey is a great source of vitamins, minerals and simple "5 a day" sugars. It has a strong classical aroma and goes well with black tea and morning porridge.

It is especially popular with kids as it looks like Winnie The Pooh honey.

Wildflower Honey

FLORAL MILD SEASONAL

The easiest way to describe wildflower honey is that most of the time it will be light and fruity. In very general terms, honey harvested later in the season (late summer and fall) will be a bit stronger in taste and darker in colour, simply because of the varieties of wildflowers which grow when it's warmer. Spring and early summer batches are more likely to be lighter in both taste and colour.



Orange Infusion Honey

ZESTY CREAMED SWEET

You will be surprised with the intensity of orange flavour notes. This creamy infusion is the the bees knees! Orange is such a versatile flavour, suitable for breakfast, lunch or dinner including dessert of course... We use only unwaxed orange peel and infuse it in honey for a long time and then it is creamed to absolute perfection. Ensuring it stays in a molten state, perfect for spreading on toast or adding to a hot beverage.



Gingerbread Spiced Honey

CHRISTMAS ON TOAST

This is what happens when you feed your bees Gingerbread cookies!

We have created this unique Christmas treat in collaboration with Spice Kitchen and it is mind-blowingly good.

You can use it in Hot Toddy, evening tea or your baking.

We have dedicated, for this infusion, our own Rapeseed honey from Longniddry near Edinburgh.

TASTES LIKE TURKISH DELIGHT


To put is simply in words. It is light, floral, very aromatic and so so tasty.

Bee Pollen

SUPER FOOD RICH IN PROTEIN

Bee pollen is a ball or pellet of field-gathered flower pollen packed by worker honeybees, and used as the primary food source for the hive. It consists of simple sugars, protein, minerals and vitamins, fatty acids, and a small percentage of other components. Also called bee bread, or ambrosia, it is stored in brood cells, mixed with saliva, and sealed with a drop of honey. Bee pollen is harvested as food for humans, with various health claims, one of them being that the fermentation process makes it much more potent than simple flower pollen.

Heather Honeycomb

Comb honey is honey intended for consumption which is still contained within its original hexagonal-shaped beeswax cells, called honeycomb. It is eaten as produced by honey bees and has received no processing, filtering, or manipulation. Heather honey is reddish/orange to dark amber. It has a slightly bitter, tangy, pungent, smoky, mildly sweet taste that persists for a long time.






